Message from the Speaker of the Grand National Assembly of Turkey

I would like to extend my gratitude and appreciation to the staff of the International Secretariat, the Head of the Turkish Delegation, Mr. Emin Önen and the staff of the Turkish Delegation to OSCE PA, as well as the administrators and personnel of the Grand National Assembly of Turkey for their dedicated and tireless work in organizing this Session.

I sincerely hope that you will enjoy, in the course of both the official and social programs, all that the wonderful city of İstanbul has to offer the participants and delegation members.
