### Lennmarker and Kanerva visit Caucasus

The OSCE delegation visited all three countries in the region, Armenia, Georgia and Azerbaijan, from 25 to 28 February. The delegation met with the leading officials from all three countries,

including the three presidents and, in Armenia, the presidentelect Serge Sargsyan as well as other presidential candidates, representatives of opposition parties and of the OSCE missions in the region.

The topics discussed included the conflicts in Nagorno-Karabakh and the Georgian-South Ossetian conflict as well
