## **Parliamentary Team** Moldova visits **Chisinau and Tiraspol**

The OSCE Parliamentary Assembly's Parliamentary Team on Moldova visited the country on 27-30 September. The Team included its Chair, Mr. Kimmo Kiljunen (Finland), Mr. Roberto Battelli (Slovenia) and Ms. Tone Tingsgård (Sweden). They were accompanied by Mr. Pentti Väänänen, Deputy Secretary General. This was the Team's third visit since its establishment in January 2000.

Upon their arrival the Team was briefed by Ambassador William Hill, Head of the OSCE Mission to Moldova. During their stay in Chisinau they met with the Speaker of the Moldovan Parliament, Mr. Dumitru Diacov, Head of the Moldovan Delegation to the OSCE PA, Mr. Alexei Turbule and other Parliamentary colleagues. In Tiraspol the Team met with Mr. Grigory Marakutsa, the Speaker, and other Members of the Supreme Soviet. In Trandniestria they also visited Russian military installations and discussed the withdrawal of military units and armaments in accordance with the Istanbul Declaration.

The purpose of the visit was to followup the resolution passed at the Ninth Annual Session in Bucharest in July. The Team also introduced their plan to organize a seminar on self-government, to be held in Finland, partly in the Åland Island, in January. This initiative was received positively by all interlocu-
