Message from the Secretary General



Welcome to the OSCE PA's 23rd Annual Session in Baku.

Meeting in Azerbaijan - at the crossroads of Europe, Central Asia and the Middle East – is a reminder of the OSCE's historic value in building bridges across geographical, political and cultural boundaries from East to

West, North to South. With its ancient cultural heritage, I am sure that Azerbaijan will provide the perfect backdrop to our Annual Session, and with their reputation for hospitality, I am sure that our hosts will ensure that it is a memorable and enjoyable occasion.

The theme for this Session, "Helsinki +40: Towards Human Security for All," is a testament to the importance that the Assembly attaches to the upcoming 40th anniversary of the landmark 1975 Helsinki Accords, as we focus our attention on how to ensure that the spirit of Helsinki endures as we face the new challenges of the 21st century.
