

# WINTER MEETING OF THE OSCE PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY

24-25-26 February 2021

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### VIRTUAL MEETING

Due to the COVID19 pandemic the 2021 Winter Meeting of the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly will take place **fully by web conferencing** on **24, 25 and 26 February 2021**. There will be therefore no presence of parliamentary delegations in Vienna.

### PROGRAMME

The Winter Meeting will be comprised of meetings of the Standing Committee, each General Committee, and a joint session of the three General Committees. The draft schedule of the meeting is attached. Note that due to the time-zones and to accommodate all delegations to extent possible meetings are scheduled over 3 consecutive afternoons (CET).

### AGENDAS AND PROCEDURE

Draft agendas for the above-mentioned meetings will be circulated in due time together with detailed information about the procedural matters.

### REGISTRATION

### TECHNICAL ASPECTS

The Winter Meeting will be held via the Zoom video-conferencing platform.

OSCE PA meetings are recorded and streamed on the internet (Social Media Platforms), and therefore open to the public.

Access to certain parts of the program may be restricted to parliamentary delegations.
